Will she perish to the hunters' arrow?

Will she die a horrible death at the hands
of the hungry lion approaching her?

She is constrained by the fire on the one side & the flowing river on the other and boxed in by her natural predators. What does she do?

She *focuses* on giving birth to a new life.

The sequence of events that follows are: Lightning strikes and blinds the hunter.

- He releases the arrow which zips past the deer and strikes the hungry lion.
- It starts to rain heavily, and the forest fire is slowly doused by the rain.
- The deer gives birth to a healthy fawn.

In our life too, there are moments of choice when we are confronted on all sides with negative thoughts and possibilities.

Some thoughts are so powerful that they overcome us and overwhelm us.

Maybe we can learn from the deer. The priority of the deer, in that given moment, was simply to give birth to a baby.
